



COVID-19 and Seabreeze: *Your Safety is our #1 Priority*

Please review our COVID-19 policies below. For the safety of our guests and staff, please know that the park will be in full compliance with all regulations established by the CDC and New York State related to the COVID-19 pandemic. After reviewing the following policies, please sign this form confirming receipt and return it to us. A scanned copy sent by email is fine. Also, please share this information with all attendees of your event.

What You Can Expect During Your Visit

- **Health Screening.** Before you enter the park, you will need to confirm the following:
 - You are not feeling sick or experiencing flu-like symptoms such as: Cough or sore throat; Shortness of breath / difficulty breathing; Fever (>100.4) or chills; Muscle Pain; New loss of taste or smell; Gastrointestinal symptoms.
 - You have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days and are not under any self-quarantine orders.
 - You have not been in contact with someone known or suspected to have symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - If you cannot confirm these questions, you and your party will not be allowed to enter the park that day.
- **Masks are Required.** Seabreeze follows all rules set by the CDC and NYS. Those 3 years and older must wear a face covering while at the park, except while seated and eating, and on water attractions. If you cannot medically tolerate a mask, you may contact the park for more information.
- **Social Distancing.** You are required to social distance from others not in your immediate circle. Markers are provided in queue lines; park benches and tables have also been arranged to assist you in meeting this requirement.
- **Sanitization.** It is recommended that you wash your hands and use hand sanitizer while at the park. Sanitization stations have been set up around the park. Tables, benches and ride vehicles are sanitized frequently by park staff. Protective barriers are used to reduce exposure to staff.
- **Signs.** Please follow all COVID-19 guidelines and policies. Look for signs throughout the park to assist you.
- **Inherent Risk.** Exposure to COVID-19 is an inherent risk in any public location where people are present; we cannot guarantee you will not be exposed during your visit.
- **Subject to Change.** All policies are subject to change. Seabreeze will remain in compliance with CDC and NYS guidelines, and will continue to work with local health officials to make adjustments as needed.
